1. I understand the relationship between standard ACEs and poor health outcomes. (Knowledge)
2. I believe addressing ACEs at societal level through community involvement and advocacy is important. (Attitude)
3. I understand other types of adversity such as that experienced by racialized minorities, children with special needs, welfare involved children, and LGBTQIA patients, as well as interplay between social emotional determinants of health. (Knowledge)
4. I feel more confident screening/providing resources/initiating a dialog. (Self-efficacy)
5. I feel more confident to become involved in establishing practices within the clinic setting. (Self-efficacy)
6. Other comments related to what you have learned or how you plan to change practices.

7. Other comments related to the speaker, topic, technical issues (audio, visual, background noise, embedded video, wifi, platform, etc) during this particular presentation?

*We were thinking to have the same questions after each speaker to ensure that we obtain enough responses. This would be a knowledge, attitudes, and self-efficacy (KASE) framework, possibly intention to change practices. We are suggesting the exact same question after each session to ensure there are enough responses. If there are two of the same item (e.g. knowledge) we would create a total score for analysis.

A knowledge, attitudes, and self-efficacy framework was used (Bandura, 1994; Schmitz, et al, 2019; Choksji, Chen, Beers, 2020).
